


























### Joint Ports' Clean Trucks Today

- 18,308 trucks are in the PDTR
- 3,860 2014+ trucks registered in the PDTR since October 1, 2018
- 10,605 trucks in the PDTR with engines meeting 2010 EPA standards
- 42% trucks in the PDTR are 2007 EPA Compliant
- 56% of the moves are being done by trucks with 2010 EPA engines
- 687 LNG/CNG trucks are in the PDTR
- 4% of the moves are being done by LNG/CNG trucks
- ~130 trucks with the natural gas fueled 0.02g/bhp-hr NOx engines are in the PDTR
- 9 ZE trucks in the PDTR




#### CTF Rate as described in the 2017 CAAP Update

**Beginning in 2020**, a Clean Truck Fund (CTF) Rate will be charged to the beneficial cargo owners that move loaded containers in and out of port terminals with trucks that do not have CARB-certified low NOx engines or better

- Contingent on:
  - Completion of Truck Feasibility Assessment, including evaluation of availability of trucks – <u>Completed April 2019</u>
  - Completion of Clean Truck Rate Study <u>Draft released, comments</u>
     <u>due January 31, 2020</u>
  - Establishment of rate collection mechanism <u>Underway</u>
  - CARB adoption of low NOx manufacturing standard <u>Anticipated</u>
     <u>March/April 2020</u>

### **CTF Rate Public Process**

- Public engagement process
  - Focused breakout meetings starting during 2017 CAAP development
  - Public workshops: August and December 2019
  - CAAP Quarterly Stakeholder Meetings
  - Email: <u>trucks@cleanairactionplan.org</u>
- Potential CTF Rate for stakeholder review and input
- Harbor Commissions' consideration of rate amount in early 2020; implementation tariff to be considered later in 2020
- Continued discussions related to incentive programs
