



Latest on new Trump tariffs



Trump's tariff strategy so far: President Trump released his America First Trade Policy memo on Monday, January 20.

- No tariffs yet: The President did not impose any tariffs on Day
 One. Instead his plan directs federal agencies to analyze trade issues
 — U.S. trade deficits, the Phase One deal with China, unfair trade practices, his idea for an External Revenue Service and report back to him by April 1.

Yes, but: On the same day, President Trump continued his 25% tariff threat on Mexico and Canada while speaking to the press. On Tuesday, he repeated the 10% tariff threat on China.

• The President said, "Probably February 1 is the date we're looking at" for putting those tariffs in place.
