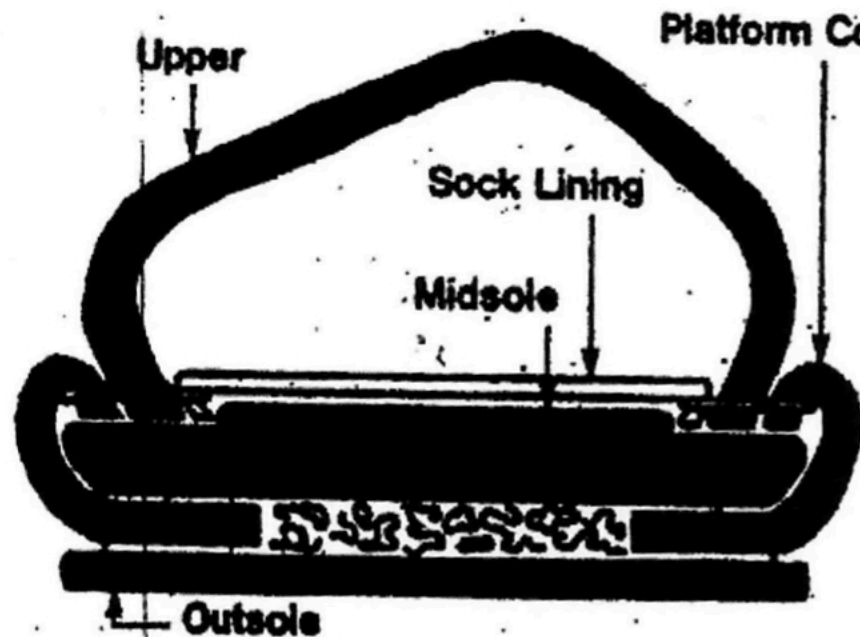


Slip-Lasted - A type of shoe construction in which the upper is stitched to a light flexible insole (or sock) so as to make a kind of bag into which the last is subsequently forced; thus the process is sometimes called "force-lasting." The main feature of this construction is the comfortable "cushioned" effect caused by a thick midsole, or platform, which is often used. Syn: California Construction.
