




Trump is the first president to serve two non-consecutive terms since Grover Cleveland in 1892; Trump will be the 47th President of the **United States**

Republicans flip four seats


Incumbent Senators Jon Tester (D-MT), Sherrod Brown (D-OH), and Bob Casey (D-PA) lost their reelection bids, while Governor Jim Justice flipped West Virginia's Senate seat following the retirement of Sen. Joe Manchin





Democrats lost their majority, but held onto four competitive seats

- Democrats had an unfavorable Senate map in 2024, having to defend close races across Ohio, Wisconsin, Pennsylvania, and Michigan
- Incumbent Senators Tammy Baldwin (WI) and Jacky Rosen (NV) held onto their seats, while Rep. Elissa Slotkin and Ruben Gallego won their races in Michigan and Arizona



119TH HOUSE OUTLOOK



Republicans have successfully defended many competitive seats and flipped eight Democratic seats



- Based on trends in both presidential and Senate races, Democrats seem unlikely to take control of the House
- Democratic candidate wins in California will determine the size of the GOP majority
