### Wants to increase teacher salaries

- Calls attention to academic results in Alabama, noting that Alabama ranks below national averages in reading and math proficiencies at certain grade levels, and calls for investments in Alabama school resources, particularly to assist Black and Latino students; vows to be an advocate for increased teacher salaries, believing that Alabama must recruit and retain high quality teachers



### Supports small businesses and financial technology

- Supports programs that would assist and attract small businesses in Alabama's 2nd District, such as expanding broadband services and offering tax incentives and sustainable resources for business owners; figures is in favor of cryptocurrency and other digital assets, stating on his campaign website that they can "stimulate innovation and technological advancement"

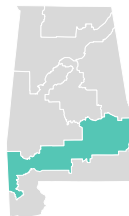

### Focused on advancing clean energy and climate resilience

- Passed Phoenix's Climate Action Plan and established the first Office of Heat Response and Mitigation in the US; built a coalition to unanimously pass the Transportation Electrification Action Plan, aiming to electrify Phoenix's bus fleet by 2040 and improve air quality



### Committed to addressing Arizona's housing shortage and affordability

- Directed over \$120 million in American Rescue Plan funding for affordable housing and homelessness relief, helping over 19,000 families with rental assistance; approved a record number of new housing units and led efforts to legalize casitas to increase housing supply in Phoenix



### Focus on reducing barriers to education and expanding opportunities

- Established the Phoenix Promise scholarship program, supporting 800 low-income students in pursuing community college education; in Congress, Ansari plans to increase funding for public schools to help students and teachers reach their full potential

- Endorsed by former President Trump's national security team; supported Trump's foreign policy strategy of "peace through strength"; criticized the withdrawal from Afghanistan as "weakness and indecision"; described border security as his "top priority;" promised to classify cartels as terrorist organizations and enact harsher punishments for fentanyl possession



### *Questioned legitimacy of past elections, promised to enact harsher punishments for fentanyl distribution*

- Claimed that the voting rights of Arizonans were "subverted" in 2022; promised to purge voter rolls and ban ranked-choice voting at the federal and state levels

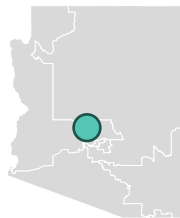

## POLICY POSITIONS



### *Proposes a slew of legislative ideas to reduce the financial burden on the middle and lower classes*

- Blames higher energy costs on the consistent need of maintenance for energy infrastructure; proposes a federal program that would finance solar panel or heat pump installations that would allow homeowners to save money on energy by producing their own; calls for reduced tariffs, believing that the real losers of trade conflicts are the consumers who are forced to pay higher prices



### *Has legislative plans to address high rent and low housing supply*

- States that rent is too high for California residents, and proposes converting empty commercial buildings into apartments and using federal funding through tax credits to help finance building conversion projects; backs a federal program that would assist middle class homeowners install accessory dwelling units or backyard homes that would become affordable rental housing

### Opposes congressional stocktrading and supports small businesses

- Supports banning members of Congress from being able to trade individual stocks while in office; proposes an all-of-the-above approach to energy developments, hoping to reduce energy costs for constituents



### Supports legislation that would protect health and air quality in his district, and protect people from the risks of wildfires

- Calls attention to the gas storage facility in the Aliso Canyon, as well as the Chiquita Canyon landfill, and supports environmental protections that would protect public health and air quality around those two locations; as the founder of Megafire Action, Whitesides is looking for better solutions to combatting and preventing wildfires, and in Congress hopes to provide incentives for homeowners that implement fire-resistant home improvements and fund measures to mitigate fire risks

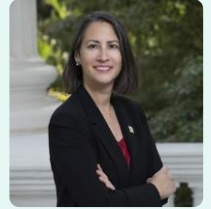

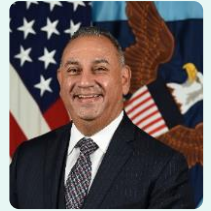

### *More moderate than other GOP candidates but agrees on necessity of reform*

- Backed the failed bipartisan immigration bill which would have added more border agents and detection technologies; although claims amendments would have been needed; opposes mass deportations but supports smaller-scale deportations of violent criminals who are undocumented immigrants



### *Grow energy resources and conserve water*

- Supports the 1922 Colorado River Compact, holding other states accountable for improperly using water; opposes exporting water resources out of the district



### *Bring down through deregulation*

- Advocates for lower housing costs by reducing tariffs on lumber and steel; wants to make federal building permitting easier; backs policy to expand the housing supply through tax incentives; wants to address the root cause of rising food prices

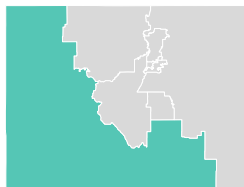

### Vocal advocate for mass deportations and a border wall

- Authored the Build the Wall and Deport Them All Act, which aimed to finish building a wall along the US-Mexico border, ban federal funding of sanctuary cities, restore the Trump-era "Remain in Mexico" policy, and mass deport undocumented persons; introduced the Fentanyl is a WMD Act in 2024, which proposed giving harsher punishments out to drug traffickers
